



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE NORTH ATLANTIC CULTURAL EXCHANGE LEAGUE (NACEL) IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION WHICH SPONSORS A SUMMER HOMESTAY PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS FROM FRANCE; AND

WHEREAS: THIS PROGRAM PLACES FRENCH STUDENTS IN AMERICAN HOMES FOR A MONTH DURING THE SUMMER WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY OFFERING AMERICAN STUDENTS AN OPPORTUNITY TO VISIT FRANCE; AND

WHEREAS: SHARING THE EXPERIENCES OF FAMILY LIFE IS A MEANINGFUL AND EFFECTIVE WAY OF LEARNING ABOUT A FOREIGN COUNTRY AND ITS PEOPLE; AND

WHEREAS: THE FRIENDSHIPS DEVELOPED THROUGH THIS PROGRAM BUILD INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATION AND RESPECT BETWEEN ALL PEOPLE AROUND THE WORLD;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 1982 TO BE

FRENCH STUDENTS MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME, FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO EXTEND TO OUR VISITORS FROM FRANCE OUR SINCERE WELCOME AND HOSPITALITY.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SECOND DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
