TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF THE COUNTY OF KANDIYOHI AND STATE OF MINNESOTA.

IN THE NAME OF THE INCORPORATION OF THE
VILLAGE OF LAKE LILLIAN.

We, the undersigned, electors residing at the date of this petition upon the land hereinafter particularly described, do respectfully petition your Honorable Body to appoint a time when and a place where, the electors actually residing upon and within the territory hereinafter described, proposed and intended to be incorporated as a Village, pursuant to Chapter 9 of the General Statutes of the State of Minnesota for the year 1925, may meet for the purpose of voting on the question whether the said territory shall be incorporated as a Village. The following is the boundary and description of the territory proposed to be incorporated as a Village, and the quantity of land embraced therein, to-wit:-

All the platted portion of the North-west quarter of the South-west quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$), and the South-west quarter of the North-west quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-three (33), and the North-east quarter of the South-east quarter (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$), and the South-east quarter of the North-east quarter (S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-four (34), in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, according to the plat of Lake Lillian Townsite, now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Kandiyohi County, Minnesota; also that part of the North-west quarter of the South-west quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$), and the South-west quarter of the North-west quarter

(S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-three (33), and the North-east quarter of the South-east quarter (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$), and the South-east quarter of the North-east quarter (S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-four (34), lying outside of the platted portion of said described premises, in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota; also that part of Sections Seven and Eighteen (7 and 18), of Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-three (33), and of Sections Twelve and Thirteen (12 and 13) in Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-four (34), in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, described by metes and bounds as follows:- Commencing at the North-east corner of the South-west quarter of the North-west quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-three (33), thence running North in a straight line parallel with the West line of Sections Seven and Eighteen (7 and 18), of Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-three (33), to the Shore of Lake Lillian, thence running in a Westerly direction on and along the Shore of Lake Lillian, to a point on a line running North and South through the centre of the East-half of Sections Twelve and Thirteen (12 and 13), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-four (34), thence running South on said line and parallel with the East line of said Sections Twelve and Thirteen (12 and 13), to the North-west corner of the South-east quarter of the North-east quarter (S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-four (34), thence running East on the forty line of said Section Thirteen (13), a distance of one-half mile to the North-east corner of the South-west quarter of the North-west quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-three (33), being the place of

beginning, the same being all adjacent and abutting on the Town-site of Lake Lillian, and suitable for Village government.

If the electors will vote and do hereafter vote for the incorporation of the aforesaid territory as a Village, we hereby ask that the said territory shall be named and designated as the Village of Lake Lillian.

We, the undersigned, further represent and show that there were on the 21st day of December, 1925, one hundred fifty-three (153) persons actually residing upon said territory at said time, which was duly ascertained under the direction of your petitioners, and by the following petitioners:- ~~E. C. from~~, E. R. Mattson, Frederick J. Lenz, Peter E. Johansen and Lars Erickson, by a census taken of said territory and the resident population as it actually was on the 21st day of December, 1925.

Your petitioners further show that the territory herein-before described and which is proposed to be incorporated as a Village, and the whole ~~whole~~ thereof, which is part of Sections Seven and Eighteen (7 and 18) of Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-three (33), and Sections Twelve and Thirteen (12 and 13) of Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Thirty-four (34), in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, is not in any incorporated village, and that a portion of same has been platted into lots and blocks, which plat has been filed and legally certified according to the Laws of the State of Minnesota, and that other land not so platted and included, is suitable for village purposes and proper subject for village government, and suitable to be used for village purposes.
