WHEREAS: A wide range of minority enterprise are available to provide valuable business services to corporations; and

WHEREAS: THE OCTOBER 8 CORPORATE MINORITY BUSINESS EXCHANGE WILL PROVIDE A MEANS FOR MINORITY FIRMS TO INCREASE PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES WITH MAJOR MINNESOTA CORPORATIONS; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS SUPPORTIVE OF PROGRAMS TO EXPAND MINORITY BUSINESS MARKETS WITHIN THE STATE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 8, 1982 to be

EXCHANGE DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THIS DAY WITH AN INCREASED AWARENESS OF COOPERATIVE EFFORTS AMONG MINORITY FIRMS AND OTHER MINNESOTA CORPORATIONS.
