



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD HAS ALWAYS BEEN DEDICATED TO PRESERVATION OF LIFE AND PROPERTY, IN PEACETIME AND IN TIME OF NATIONAL EMERGENCY, BOTH ON LAND AND AT SEA; AND

WHEREAS: THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD IS CELEBRATING ITS 192ND ANNIVERSARY ON AUGUST 4, 1982, SAID DATE COMMEMORATING ALSO ANOTHER YEAR OF CONTINUOUS, OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO OUR CITIZENS ON THE INLAND WATERS OF THE UNITED STATES; AND

WHEREAS: THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD IS TO BE COMMENDED FOR ITS UNTIRING EFFORTS TOWARDS EDUCATING OUR CITIZENS IN WATER SAFETY, PROTECTING OUR ENVIRONMENT FROM POLLUTION, ASSISTING OUR CITIZENS DURING FLOOD RELIEF ACTIVITIES, AND FULFILLING ITS NUMEROUS OTHER HUMANITARIAN MISSIONS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AUGUST 4, 1982 TO BE

COAST GUARD DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO TAKE RECOGNITION OF THE 192ND ANNIVERSARY OF THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SECOND DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
