WHEREAS: Demographic and health trends suggest that deaths from cancer may number about eight million annually by the year 2000, according to the World Health Organization report; and

WHEREAS: THE UNITED CANCER INSTITUTE HAS PROPOSED A CANCER CONTROL PROGRAM TO SET UP MINI-CANCER DETECTION FACILITIES THROUGHOUT THE NATION TO GIVE TO THOSE WHO CAN'T AFFORD IT A FREE CANCER CHECK-UP DURING SEPTEMBER 7 - 11. 1982; AND

WHEREAS: THE EARLY DETECTION AND TREATMENT OF CANCER IN 1TS EARLY STAGES WOULD RESULT IN THE SAVINGS OF MILLIONS OF LIVES EACH YEAR;

NOW. THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO. HEREBY PROCLAIM SEPTEMBER 8, 1982 TO BE

NATIONAL CANCER, DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SEVENTEENTH DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
