WHEREAS: THE BRAILLE SPORTS FOUNDATION IS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND PROMOTION OF ATHLETIC PROGRAMS FOR THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED; AND

WHEREAS: THE BRAILLE SPORTS FOUNDATION NATIONAL BEEP BASEBALL TOURNAMENT WILL BE HELD AT ST. LOUIS PARK'S AQUILA AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL FIELDS AUGUST 26, 27 AND 28, AND WILL BRING FAVORABLE NATIONAL ATTENTION TO ST. LOUIS PARK AND THE STATE OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: THE SPIRIT, ENTHUSIASM AND ACHIEVEMENT OF THE PARTICIPANTS ARE A DELIGHT TO BEHOLD AND AN INSPIRATION TO ALL MINNESOTANS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AUGUST 22 THROUGH AUGUST 28, 1982 TO BE
