WHEREAS: Over half of the women age 16 and over are in the labor force, and that percentage is rising; and

WHEREAS: For more than a half century, the National Federation of Business and Professional Women's Clubs has helped to promote the interests of Business and professional women, encouraging a spirit of cooperation and the development of New Opportunities for Education in Industrial, scientific, and vocational fields; and

WHEREAS: THE FEDERATION HAS KEPT IN STEP WITH THE ASPIRATIONS AND NEEDS OF WOMEN, AND EQUALLY IMPORTANT, IT HAS STRESSED ADVANCEMENT BASED ON DEMONSTRATED CAPACITY TO LEAD;

NOW. THEREFORE. I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 17 THROUGH 23, 1982 TO BE

BUSINESS WOMEN'S WEEK

IN MINNESOTA. AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
