VILLAGE OF DEEPAVEN.
 An Ordinance To Annex Certain Lots and
 Blocks of Land to the Village of Deep-
 haven.

The Village Council of the Village of Deep-
 haven, County of Hennepin, State of Minne-
 sota, do Ordain as follows:

That the following described lots and blocks
 of land lying in the Township of Excelsior
 and adjacent to the Village of Deephaven,
 be and the same are hereby annexed to the
 Village of Deephaven, commencing on the N. line of
 NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 26, T. 100 N., R. 23 E.,
 at a point 886 1/2 ft. W. of the corner thereof,
 thence N. to the N. line of NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of
 Sec. 26, thence E. parallel with the center line
 of the Minneapolis and Excelsior road, thence
 Northeastly along center line of said road
 to a point 233 1/2 ft. Southwesterly from
 its intersection with the line of NW 1/4 of SE 1/4
 of Sec. 26, thence N. to beginning of road, Sec. 26,
 T. 100 N., R. 23 E., 702 1/2 acres more or less
 owned by Geo. W. Zachris, Willie Zachris,
 Louise W. W. M. Hughes, Ed. J. Summer-
 house, Chas. W. Seabury, S. Williams, G.
 Spaulding, H. A. Kerson, Dickinson, & Gillespie,
 and other owners, together with all its sub-
 divisions, buildings, etc., and the same are
 hereby declared to be a part of said Village
 of Deephaven as effectively as if they had
 originally been a part thereof.

This ordinance shall be in effect at once af-
 ter its passage, passed and approved by Vil-
 lage Council at regular session on Dec. 11,
 1925.
