

Proclamation

WHEREAS: 80,000 MINNESOTANS HAVE SOME FORM OF EPILEPSY; AND

- WHEREAS: 60 PERCENT OF THOSE PERSONS WHO HAVE EPILEPSY ARE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AGE OR YOUNGER; AND
- WHEREAS: IN MINNESOTA THERE IS APPROXIMATELY ONE CHILD IN EVERY OTHER CLASSROOM WITH EPILEPSY; AND
- WHEREAS: EPILEPSY IS THE SECOND MOST COMMON NEUROLOGICAL DYSFUNCTION, WE SALUTE THE 5,000 MINNESOTA JAYCEE WOMEN AND LOCAL MINNESOTA JAYCEE WOMEN FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION IN AN EPILEPSY PUBLIC EDUCATION COOPERATIVE PROJECT OF THE MINNESOTA EPILEPSY LEAGUE AND THE MINNESOTA JAYCEE WOMEN;

NOW. THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1982 TO BE

EPILEPSY. MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE, ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THIS CONDITION AND ASSIST THOSE WHO HAVE IT TO SUCCEED IN OUR COMMUNITY.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL, of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-two and of the State the one hundred twenty-fourth.
