WHEREAS: The year of 1982 marks the 100th anniversary of a friendship treaty between the Republic of Korea and the United States: and

WHEREAS: THROUGHOUT THE HISTORY OF BOTH COUNTRIES, THE UNITED STATES HAS SUPPORTED THE FREEDOM AND INDEPENDENCE OF KOREAN PEOPLE, AND KOREA HAS BEEN A STRONG ALLY AGAINST THE COMMUNIST THREAT AND EXPANSIONISM; AND

WHEREAS: Korea is the 12th largest trade partner of the United States: AND

WHEREAS: There are many Korean residents in the State of Minnesota, engaged in the fields of business, commerce, medicine, education and culture:

NOW. THEREFORE. I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE YEAR OF 1982 TO BE

KOREA - U.S. FRIENDSHIP YEAR

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO COMMEMORATE AND RECOGNIZE A LONG AND RESPECTED FRIENDLY RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES AND FURTHER DEVELOP A STRONGER ALLEGIANCE IN THE FUTURE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
