WHEREAS: Lupus Erythematosus is a chronic inflammatory disease of the body's connective tissue that occurs in two forms - discoid, which affects the skin, or the more serious form: Systemic, which can attack any organ of the body; and

WHEREAS: Lupus Erythematosus is one of the ten major illnesses in the United States affecting approximately one million Americans; and

WHEREAS: Lupus is also called an autoimmune disease in which the patient's immune system is out of control; and

WHEREAS: Lupus can strike men and women at any age, but 85% of the cases occur in females between the ages of 10 and 40; and

WHEREAS: With Early Diagnosis and treatment, an 85% survival rate is possible; and

WHEREAS: THE LUPUS FOUNDATION OF AMERICA AND OUR MINNESOTA CHAPTER, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, WAS FORMED TO GAIN PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THIS MULTI-FACETED DISEASE AND TO SUPPORT RESEARCH IN ORDER TO SEEK NEW METHODS OF CONTROL, PREVENTION AND HOPEFULLY, TO FIND A CURE;
