WHEREAS: This effort helps to promote freedom of the press; and

WHEREAS: Each year, a special day is set aside to recognize the efforts, initiative, creativity and dedication of newspaper carriers throughout Minnesota;

NOW. THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SATURDAY, OCTOBER 16, 1982 TO BE

NEWSPAPER CARRIE'R DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME, FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO RECOGNIZE THIS SERVICE PROVIDED BY OUR YOUNG PEOPLE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO. AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
