
The Minnesota Municipal Board has now processed and approved the above ordinance in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 414, and the Rules of Procedure.



ORDINANCE NO. 86

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits to the City of Spicer, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Minnesota, to Include Certain Lands not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres.

WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Spicer, a municipal corporation of the State of Minnesota, by the property owner having the sole interest therein, to have certain real property hereinafter described included in the limits of the City of Spicer, and

WHEREAS, it is proposed to annex by virtue hereof to said City of Spicer, said property all of which property is in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the property to be annexed is described as follows:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 120 North, Range 34 West of the 5th P.M., Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of said Section 10, which said point is 492 feet East of the Northwest corner thereof; thence at an angle of 88 degrees and 46 minutes to the Southeast a distance of 296 feet to a point; thence deflecting 5 degrees to the left a distance of 279 feet to a point; thence deflecting 18 degrees and 8 minutes to the left a distance of 79.21 feet more or less, to a point on a line parallel with and 642.43 feet, more or less, distant Southerly from the aforesaid North line of Section 10, which said point is 560 feet, more or less, East from the West line of said Section 10; thence due East a distance of 5.27 feet to a point; thence Northerly and parallel with the center line of Trunk Highway No. 23, a distance of 660 feet to a point on the said North line of Section 10; thence West on and along the said North line a distance of 224.5 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.95 acres, be the same more or less,

ALSO, that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 10, and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, all in Township 120 North, Range 34 West of the 5th P.M., Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, the boundaries of which tract shall be as follows: the North line of said tract shall be the North section line of said Sections 9 and 10 and shall extend from the point of intersection of the North line of said Section 9 with the East right-of-way line of Highway No. 23 to a point on said North line of said Section 10, 492 feet East of the Northwest corner

of said Section 10; the South line shall be parallel with the North line and 660 feet South thereof; the West line shall be the East right-of-way line of Highway No. 23; the East line shall be the East line of the property of Jessie S. Greulich in said Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter of said Section 10 in said County and State, as said East line is established in that certain Quit Claim Deed dated July 29, 1938, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, in Book 86 of Deeds on page 382.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Township of Green Lake, having waived any objections or the period of making objections to the annexation herein, has consented to the annexation of said territory to the City of Spicer;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Spicer has recommended to the Council that the premises be zoned as follows:

- a. B-2 Highway Commercial District, the Westerly one-half thereof;
- b. R-4 Multiple Residential District, the Westerly one-half of said parcel.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Spicer hereby determines, ordains, and declares as follows:

I.

That the annexation would be in the best interest of the City of Spicer, Minnesota, and to the best interest of the property affected.

II.

That the property above-described abuts on the city limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City Government.

III.

That the property is hereby annexed to and included within, the City of Spicer, Minnesota, as effectually as if it has originally been a part hereof.

IV.

That the premises shall be zoned upon annexation as follows:


- a. B-2 Highway Commercial District, the Westerly one-half thereof;
- b. R-4 Multiple Residential District, the Westerly one-half of said parcel.

V.

That this Ordinance shall be filed and shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the filing of a copy of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Green Lake Town Clerk, Kandiyohi County Auditor, and the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, from and after its passage and publication.




