



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF ALL SYSTEMS OF IMPARTIAL DECISION-MAKING IS THE FULLEST MEASURE OF JUSTICE FOR ALL; AND

WHEREAS: ARBITRATION IS A STRONG VOLUNTARY MECHANISM FOR DISPUTE RESOLUTION WHICH INSURES PROMPT, EQUITABLE DISPOSITION OF CONFLICTS TO THE BENEFIT OF CITIZENS, COURTS AND GOVERNMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION HAS BEEN A SIGNIFICANT FORCE IN MAKING ARBITRATION PART OF THE JUDICIAL AND SOCIAL FABRIC OF MINNESOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM NOVEMBER 5, 1982 TO BE

ARBITRATION DAY

IN MINNESOTA, FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO ACKNOWLEDGE THIS DAY APPROPRIATELY AND TO EXTEND GREETINGS AND APPRECIATION TO THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION FOR THE SERVICE IT HAS RENDERED AND WILL CONTINUE TO RENDER, FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I HAVE HEREUNTO SET MY HAND AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTEENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
