



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: MANY CITIZENS IN THE AREA ARE IN IMMEDIATE NEED OF EMERGENCY FOOD SERVICES; AND

WHEREAS: THE FOOD BANK WAS ORGANIZED AS A RESPONSE TO HUNGER IN OUR COMMUNITY AND IS A COOPERATIVE VENTURE OF BUSINESS, COMMUNITY AND SERVICES AGENCIES TO COLLECT AND DISTRIBUTE FOOD TO THE HUNGRY; AND

WHEREAS: EACH FALL, A HARVEST FOR THE HUNGRY CAMPAIGN IS ORGANIZED SO THAT INDIVIDUALS, GROUPS, AND ORGANIZATIONS WILL BE REMINDED OF THE ONGOING NEED FOR FOOD FOR THE LESS FORTUNATE IN OUR COMMUNITY, WITH THE HARVEST FOR THE HUNGRY COMMITTEE BEING MADE UP OF COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS; AND

WHEREAS: THE FOOD IS DIVIDED AMONG 30 FOOD SHELVES LOCATED IN THE EASTERN METROPOLITAN AREA FOR INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES WHO FIND THEMSELVES IN A CRISIS SITUATION AND ALSO GOES TO ON-SITE FEEDING PROGRAMS FOR THE DISADVANTAGED WITH OVER A MILLION POUNDS OF FOOD HAVING BEEN DISTRIBUTED SINCE JANUARY, 1982; AND

WHEREAS: THIS PROGRAM IS EFFECTIVELY CONTRIBUTING TO A GREATER QUALITY OF LIFE FOR MINNESOTA CITIZENS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 17 THROUGH 24, 1982 TO BE

### HARVEST FOR THE HUNGRY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO ACKNOWLEDGE THIS TIME APPROPRIATELY.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I HAVE HEREUNTO SET MY HAND AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTEENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
