WHEREAS: Major goals of Alpha Delta Kappa, an international honorary sorority FOR WOMEN EDUCATORS ARE TO GIVE RECOGNITION TO OUTSTANDING EDUCATORS. TO BUILD A FRATERNAL FELLOWSHIP AMONG EDUCATORS ADDING TO THEIR EFFECTIVE-NESS IN THE PROMOTING OF EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION, AND TO ESTABLISH HIGH STANDARDS OF EDUCATION; AND
