



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: MEMBERS OF THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF LEGAL SECRETARIES ADHERE TO A STRICT CODE OF ETHICS, MAINTAINING THE HIGHEST STANDARDS IN THEIR CONTACTS WITH GOVERNMENT, COURTS, LAW OFFICES, CLIENTS, AND ALL PERSONS; AND

WHEREAS: THE EFFICIENCY OF THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF LEGAL SECRETARIES IS OF FIRST IMPORTANCE TO GOVERNMENT, THE COURTS, AND TO ATTORNEYS AND THEIR CLIENTS; AND

WHEREAS: ONE OF THE AIMS AND PURPOSES OF THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF LEGAL SECRETARIES IS TO FURTHER THE EDUCATION OF ITS MEMBERS AND TO INCREASE THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF THE LAW; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST THAT LEGAL SECRETARIES HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO OBSERVE THE GOVERNMENT WITH WHICH THEY ARE SO CLOSELY ASSOCIATED BY REASON OF THEIR PROFESSION AS LEGAL SECRETARIES;

THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 11 THROUGH 15, 1982 TO BE

MINNESOTA. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO ACKNOWLEDGE THIS WEEK APPROPRIATELY TO RECOGNIZE AND APPRECIATE THE SAFEGUARDS TO OUR LIBERTY PROVIDED BY GOVERNMENT OF LAWS AND BY THE ORDERLY PROCESS OF OUR COURTS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I HAVE HEREUNTO SET MY HAND AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTEENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
