WHEREAS: CAREER GUIDANCE PROVIDES INDIVIDUALS WITH SKILLS TO EXPLORE, UNDER-STAND AND PERFORM IN A MAJOR LIFE ROLE - ONE'S CHOICE OF VOCATION; AND

WHEREAS: As an essential part of Minnesota's educational process, meaningful career education and guidance help bridge the gap between the business, industry and labor communities and the schools with career guidance helping each individual develop meaningful alternatives from which to select a work identity; and

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAS PLACED INCREASED EMPHASIS ON CAREER GUIDANCE FOR ALL PEOPLE TO ASSIST THEM IN PREPARING FOR THEIR FUTURES WITH THIS TASK BECOMING A LIFELONG PROCESS WHICH REACHES FAR BEYOND SCHOOLS INTO THE AGENCIES WITHIN EVERY COMMUNITY;
