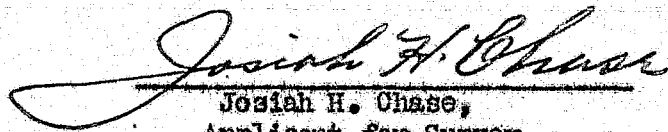
Dear Sir:-

You will please take notice, that the undersigned, will, within 30 days, file an application in the General Land Office, at Washington, D. C., for the survey of that certain Unsurveyed Island located in Crane Lake, St. Louis County, Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

An Unsurveyed Island located on the Section line between Sections 13 and 24, Township 67 North, Range 17 West, 4th P.M., lying due East 9.52 chains from the M.O. on the South-east point of Lot 3 of Sec. 13-67-17, containing approximately 3.45 acres.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Island should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
