NOW. THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 17 THROUGH 23, 1982 TO BE

PHYSICAL THERAPY WEEK.
