



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF TOLE AND DECORATIVE PAINTERS HAS CONTRIBUTED TO THE CULTURE OF THIS NATION THROUGH THE ARTISTIC ENDEAVORS OF ITS MEMBERS; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF TOLE AND DECORATIVE PAINTERS IS WORKING TOWARD THE PRESERVATION OF THE ARTISTIC HERITAGE OF OUR NATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF TOLE AND DECORATIVE PAINTERS HAS ELEVATED THE ART OF TOLE AND DECORATIVE PAINTING THROUGH ITS PUBLICATIONS, ITS EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND ITS STIMULATION OF INTEREST IN AND APPRECIATION FOR THE ART OF TOLE AND DECORATIVE PAINTING; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF TOLE AND DECORATIVE PAINTERS AND ITS CHAPTERS CONTRIBUTE TO MANY WORTHWHILE LOCAL CAUSES THROUGH THEIR ACTIVITIES; AND

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 17 THROUGH 24, 1982 TO BE
