AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBERTVILLE, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS OF ALBERTVILLE.

whereas, a certain Petition dated April 4, 1979, terquesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 70 day of m., 1979, and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all owners of said territory, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Frankfort Township has executed a Waiver by which they state that Frankfort Township has no objection to the annexation of the hereinafter described territory to the City of Albertville, and

WHERENS, the City Council of the City of Albertwille has discussed and is aware of the Stipulations placed on the bottom of the Waiver signed by the Town Board of Transfort Town ship:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in characters and (2) that mohe of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.
