WHEREAS: THE SCHUBERT CLUB IS CELEBRATING ONE HUNDRED YEARS OF SERVICE BY FULFILLING ITS MANDATE - TO PROMOTE THE ART OF MUSIC, PARTICULARLY RECITAL MUSIC, THROUGH EDUCATION, PERFORMANCE AND MUSEUM PROGRAMS, AND TO MAINTAIN A HIGH STANDARD OF EXCELLENCE; AND

WHEREAS: THE SCHUBERT CLUB PRESENTS THE FINEST ARTISTS IN THE WORLD IN RECITAL - A CHAMBER SERIES - AND FOR THE RADIO LISTENING AUDIENCE, UPPER MIDWEST ARTISTS ON "LIVE FROM LANDMARK"; AND

WHEREAS: THE SCHUBERT CLUB HAS MET ITS EDUCATIONAL GOALS THROUGH MASTER CLASSES, MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS AND INSTRUCTION THROUGH PROJECT CHEER & MUSIC THERAPY; AND

WHEREAS: THE SCHUBERT CLUB MAINTAINS A MUSEUM OF HISTORIC KEYBOARD INSTRUMENTS KEPT LIVING BY THEIR USE IN PERFORMANCES; AND

WHEREAS: THE SCHUBERT CLUB SHOULD BE COMMENDED FOR WHAT IT HAS ACCOMPLISHED AND FOR ITS GIFT TO THE FUTURE OF TEN NEW WORKS THIS YEAR;
