



Proclamation

WHEREAS: SINCE 1947, AFS INTERNATIONAL/INTERCULTURAL PROGRAMS HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO BROADENING THE HORIZONS OF THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA THROUGH PERSONAL CONTACT WITH STUDENTS FROM AROUND THE WORLD; AND

WHEREAS: IN 1982, 129 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM MINNESOTA HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO LIVE ABROAD WITH AFS FAMILIES; AND

WHEREAS: THIS YEAR, 197 FAMILIES OF MINNESOTA ARE EXPERIENCING THE CLOSE RELATIONSHIP OF AN AFS DAUGHTER OR SON; AND

WHEREAS: AFS IS EXPANDING THE OUTLOOK OF HUNDREDS OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS THROUGH AFS CLUBS AND CONTRIBUTING TO CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT IN 163 MINNESOTA SCHOOLS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM NOVEMBER 12, 1982 TO BE
