WHEREAS: THE QUALITY OF OUR COMMUNITY LIFE BEGINS WITHIN THE HOMES OF INDIVIDUAL FAMILIES; AND

THE MOST IMPORTANT WORK WE CAN DO IS WITHIN THE WALLS OF OUR HOMES, WHICH IS THE BEST PLACE TO NURTURE THE STRENGTHS WE NEED THE MOST - FAITH IN THE FUTURE, HARD WORK, HONESTY, RESPECT FOR OTHERS, UNSELFISHNESS AND ALL OTHER QUALITIES THAT HAVE WORKED WELL IN THE PAST; AND

WHEREAS: FAMILY NIGHTS, WHEN HELD REGULARLY, HAVE PROVEN MOST BENEFICIAL IN BRINGING THE MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY CLOSER TOGETHER THROUGH MEANINGFUL ACTIVITIES WHICH PROMOTE BETTER COMMUNICATION AND UNDERSTANDING;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 21 THROUGH 27, 1982 TO BE
