

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAS BEEN A LEADER IN THE COMMUNITY EDUCATION MOVEMENT SINCE IT WAS INITIATED IN MINNESOTA AT THE 1969 CONFERENCE ON THE LIGHTED SCHOOL CALLED BY GOVERNOR HAROLD LEVANDER; AND

- WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA LEGISLATURE HAS CONSISTENTLY SUPPORTED THE COMMUNITY EDUCATION CONCEPT IN EACH LEGISLATIVE SESSION SINCE THE FIRST LEGISLATION WAS PASSED IN 1971; AND
- WHEREAS: LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS, CITIZEN ADVISORY COUNCILS, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS THROUGHOUT MINNESOTA HAVE SUPPORTED THE COMMUNITY EDUCATION CONCEPT; AND
- WHEREAS: COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROVIDES FOR FULL USE OF SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY FACILITIES TO BRING LIFELONG LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES TO PEOPLE OF ALL AGES, FROM ALL WALKS OF LIFE, AND THE RIGHT TO EDUCATION TO EVERY CITIZEN IN THE STATE; AND
- WHEREAS: COMMUNITY EDUCATION IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE TOTAL EDUCATIONAL EFFORT OF A COMMUNITY; AND
- WHEREAS: November 17, 1982 has been declared National Community Education Day and incorporated as part of American Education Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do Hereby proclaim November 17, 1982 to be

COMMUNITY EDUCATION DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND CALL UPON THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA TO RECOGNIZE AND PARTICIPATE IN THIS OBSERVANCE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF NOVEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
