



Proclamation

WHEREAS: KEY CLUB INTERNATIONAL, A HIGH SCHOOL SERVICE ORGANIZATION SPONSORED BY KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL AND IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS COMPRISED OF OVER 290 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN 12 SCHOOLS ACROSS THE STATE; AND

WHEREAS: THE MEMBERS OF KEY CLUBS ARE PART OF AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF OVER 104,000 STUDENTS DEDICATED TO SERVE WITH PURPOSE THEIR GOD, COUNTRY, AND FELLOW MAN, SEEKING TO GIVE PRIMACY TO HUMAN AND SPIRITUAL RATHER THAN TO THE MATERIAL VALUES OF LIFE; AND

WHEREAS: THEY PROMOTE THE ADOPTION OF HIGHER STANDARDS IN SCHOLASTICS, SPORTSMANSHIP, SOCIAL CONTACTS AND A MORE CONCERNED CITIZENSHIP; AND

WHEREAS: THROUGH THEIR PURPOSEFUL SERVICE THEY HAVE HELPED TO BUILD BETTER COMMUNITIES WHERE RIGHTEOUSNESS, JUSTICE, PATRIOTISM, AND GOODWILL ARE GOALS FOR LIVING; AND

WHEREAS: THE CURRENT ADOPTED THEME OF "STRENGTHEN FROM WITHIN" AND ITS RELATED PROJECTS FOCUS ON THE INDIVIDUAL COMMITMENT TO THE FUNDAMENTALS OF KEY CLUB INTERNATIONAL - PRIDE, CONCERN, LOVE, CARING;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM NOVEMBER 7 THROUGH 13, 1982 TO BE
