

RESOLUTION CANVASSING ELECTION AND ANNOUNCING RESULTS

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Adams, Minnesota, that it is hereby found and determined that at the special election held in the City of Adams on November 2, 1982, to vote on the following question:

Currently the city operates and intends to continue to operate a municipal liquor store. Shall the city of Adams in addition be authorized to issue private "on-sale" licenses to hotel and restaurants as defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.07?

there were 153 votes in favor of the question, 280 votes against the question, and 8 ballots were illegible, spoiled, or otherwise defective and the question is hereby declared to be
