

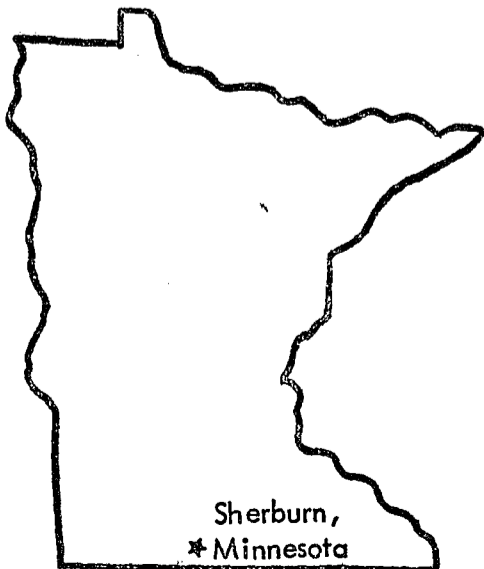

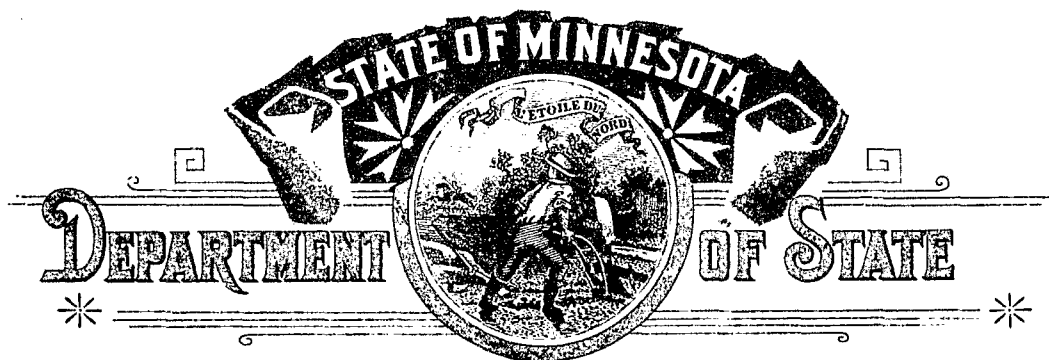
The voters cast a 310 to 299 in favor of allowing the City to sell liquor licenses to private operators as well as continue operating the City owned municipal liquor store.
