

## **Proclamation**

WHEREAS: PROTECTION OF THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE TWO MILLION CITIZENS LIVING IN THE SEVEN-COUNTY TWIN CITIES METROPOLITAN AREA IS OF GREAT IMPORTANCE; AND

WHERERAS: More than 200 police, fire, sheriff, ambulance and other emergency services are available in this area; and

WHEREAS: There are presently 77 central telephone offices servicing 1,137,000 telephones linking these citizens with these services; and

WHEREAS: A New single emergency telephone number - 911 - will replace all emergency police, fire and medical numbers in the seven-county Twin Cities metropolitan area beginning December 1, 1982;

NOW. THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 1, 1982 TO BE

IN MINNESOTA, AND CALL UPON THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA TO RECOGNIZE AND PARTICIPATE IN THIS OBSERVANCE.
