



Proclamation

WHEREAS: AGRICULTURE IS MINNESOTA'S OLDEST INDUSTRY; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA IS BLESSED WITH A WIDE VARIETY AND ABUNDANCE OF CROPS AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCED ON 105,000 FARMS; AND

WHEREAS: THE MARKET VALUE OF THESE PRODUCTS APPROXIMATES SEVEN BILLION DOLLARS; AND

WHEREAS: SCHOOLS SERVE MORE MEALS THAN ANY OTHER ORGANIZATION IN MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: APPROXIMATELY 450,000 CHILDREN RECEIVE ONE THIRD OF THEIR DAILY NUTRITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FROM THIS PROGRAM; AND

WHEREAS: FOOD IS AN ABSOLUTE NECESSITY IN BUILDING SOUND BODIES AND MINDS OF YOUNG STUDENTS; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM IS DEDICATED TO PROVIDING HIGHLY NUTRITIOUS MEALS AT A REASONABLE COST;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JANUARY 9, 1983 TO BE

ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL MINNESOTA SCHOOLS

AND CALL UPON THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA TO RECOGNIZE AND PARTICIPATE IN THIS OBSERVANCE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS THIRTIETH DAY OF NOVEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOURTH.
