WHEREAS: THE PUBLIC SHOULD BE AWARE OF THE ROLE THAT THEY PLAY AS CONSUMERS AND BUSINESS PEOPLE IN THE CONTINUED SUCCESS AND GROWTH OF THIS SYSTEM; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA DISTRIBUTIVE EDUCATION CLUBS OF AMERICA, BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY, AND CONCERNED CITIZENS ARE NOW TAKING AN ACTIVE ROLE IN EDUCATING THE PUBLIC ON OUR AMERICAN FREE ENTERPRISE SYSTEM;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JANUARY 16 THROUGH 22, 1983 TO BE
