AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COKATO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND (UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEINDG 200 ACRES IN AREA) ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was not required; and,

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the City limits at the south boundary thereof;

The council of the City of Cokato, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City council hereby determines (1) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The North 150 feet of the following described tract: Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW4 of SW4) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Twenty-eight (28), thence South on East line of said forty acre tract, 47.5 rods; thence West 20 rods; thence North 47.5 rods; thence East 20 rods to beginning, all lines to run to government surveys, Wright County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The City clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State,

the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval of the ordinance by the Minnesota Municipal Board.


