



Proclamation

EAS: A crime was committed every three minutes in Minnesota during the first nine months of 1982;

EAS: The prevention of crime should be the objective of all Minnesotans concerned with safer homes streets and neighborhoods; and

EAS: Each Minnesotan can cooperate with law enforcement officials to resist crime by locking doors and windows and promoting safe neighborhoods; and

EAS: Crime prevention strategies like Operation Identification, a free burglary reduction program available from local police and sheriff departments, and Neighborhood Watch do work to curtail crime; and

EAS: Effective crime prevention requires each Minnesotan to take the initiative in discouraging persons from committing unlawful acts;

THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 6 through February 12, 1983 to be

CRIME PREVENTION WEEK

Minnesota, and urge all citizens to practice crime prevention techniques available from local police and sheriff departments designed to help people avoid becoming victims of burglary, assault, theft and other crimes.
