- REAS: Home economics is a profession founded in research and education primarily concerned with improving the quality of life for individuals and families; and
- ?EAS: Home economists are active in education, business, communications, research, public policy legislation, energy, housing, consumer homemaking, aged and handicapped, and voluntary professional and community service; and
- REAS: Through professional knowledge and skills, home economists improve the living standards and the quality of individual family and community life; and
- EAS: The American Home Economics Association, a national educational and scientific organization founded in 1909, is among the 15 largest professional organizations in the United States, with a membership of more than 35,000 men and women; and
- ¿EAS: The Minnesota Home Economics Association, one of the largest state affiliates of AHEA, has a membership of over 1,100 home economics professionals; and
