EAS: The Minnesota Jaycee Women provide individual development to tomorrow's leaders; and


EAS: Their creed states, "May we leave the world a better place because we lived and served within


THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 13 through February 19, 1983 to be
