WHEREAS: MENTAL RETARDATION AFFECTS MORE THAN SIX MILLION CHILDREN AND ADULTS IN THE UNITED STATES, AND ABOUT 120,000 IN MINNESOTA, AS WELL AS THEIR

FAMILIES AND FRIENDS, AND;

WHEREAS: DURING THE MONTH OF MARCH, THE ASSOCIATION FOR RETARDED CITIZENS, THE JAYCEES AND THE JAYCEE WOMEN OF MINNESOTA WILL BE CONDUCTING EDUCATIONAL, FUNDRAISING, AND MEMBERSHIP PROGRAMS; AND

WHEREAS: PUBLIC UNDERSTANDING IS THE KEY TO A MENTALLY RETARDED PERSON'S ENJOYMENT OF A FULL AND REWARDING LIFE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1983 TO BE

MENTAL RETARDATION MONTH

IN MINNESOTA. FURTHER, I URGE THE HELP OF ALL CITIZENS OF THIS STATE TO JOIN WITH ME IN GIVING FULL SUPPORT TO EFFORTS TO HELP OUR MENTALLY RETARDED CITIZENS ENJOY A SELF-SUFFICIENT WAY OF LIFE.
