WHEREAS: The need for a vocational student organization to provide for the students enrolled in office education programs was recognized over a decade ago; and

WHEREAS: The Office Education Association was established in 1966 as an independent organization for students enrolled in secondary and post secondary business and office education programs; and

WHEREAS: Membership in the Office Education Association is without regard to race, creed or national origin; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Office Education Association was organized to help students develop their skills and leadership abilities through participation in vocational education, civic, recreational and special activities; and

WHEREAS: The Office Education Association is an integral part of vocational education;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 7 through February 13, 1983 to be

MINNESOTA OFFICE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION WEEK

in Minnesota. Further, I urge citizens to commend the Minnesota Office Education Association for its worthwhile purpose in uniting students enrolled in classes with business and office education as their objective.
