- REAS: School Counselor Week will be a means to focus public attention on guidance and counselor programs and to increase the understanding of the public regarding the importance of these programs for Minnesota youth; and
- REAS: School counselors in the State of Minnesota provide service to our young people and their families in both public and non-public schools; and
- REAS: The skilled individuals in the positions as school counselor are licensed by the State of Minnesota; and
- REAS: Group and individual counseling is practiced by our school counselors in order to develop the social, emotional and intellectual growth of all students; and
- REAS: It is critical that our Minnesota students continue to receive assistance in planning careers and life goals; and
- REAS: Minnesota School Counselors are deeply involved in issues of equality of education, human rights, and the reduction of racial and sex bias within our educational system; and
- REAS: We recognize the American School Counselors Association and its National School Guidance Week of February 7th, 1983;
