

Proclamation

THEREAS: WE ARE IN THE MIDST OF WINTER, AND MINNESOTA LIES IN THE REGION OF FREQUENT SEVERE WINTER STORMS; AND

VHEREAS: ON NOVEMBER 10-11, 1940 A STORM KNOWN AS THE "ARMISTICE DAY BLIZZARD" KILLED 49 PEOPLE; AND

*HEREAS: ON MARCH 15-16, 1941 A BLIZZARD OVER NORTHERN MINNESOTA NOTED FOR ITS SUDDENNESS AND SEVERITY KILLED 37 PEOPLE; AND

THEREAS: ON MARCH 17, 1967 THE "ST. PATRICK'S DAY BLIZZARD" DUMPED NEARLY TWO FEET OF SNOW IN CENTRAL MINNESOTA; AND

HEREAS: ON JANUARY 10-11, 1975 THE BLIZZARD KNOWN AS THE "STORM OF THE CENTURY" PRODUCED DRIFTS TO 20 FEET AND KILLED 14 PEOPLE; AND

#HEREAS: IN JANUARY OF 1982 RECORD HEAVY SNOW STORMS AND A BLIZZARD DUMPED THREE FEET OF SNOW IN PARTS OF MINNESOTA KILLING TWO PEOPLE, STRANDING THOUSANDS OF MOTORISTS, AND COLLAPSING BUILDINGS; AND

THEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAS JOINED WITH THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN RECOGNIZING THE NEED FOR A BROAD PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAM ON SEVERE WINTER WEATHER;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JANUARY 16 THROUGH JANUARY 22, 1983 TO BE

WINTER AWARENESS WEEK

N MINNESOTA. FURTHER, I URGE THE CITIZENRY, NEWS MEDIA, EDUCATORS, AND OTHERS TO GIVE THEIR SUPPORT TO THIS WORTHY EFFORT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINETEENTH DAY OF JANUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIFTH.
