WHEREAS: Metro area food shelves are attempting to meet emergency food needs of the poor; and

WHEREAS: The food contribution of metro area churches and synagogues is crucial to the stocking of metro area food shelves;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1983 to be
