For thirty-four years international members have contributed their time, talents and WHEREAS: resources to help foster, promote and encourage all phases of mutual understanding among Christians everywhere, regardless of race, color or creed; and

The problems of men and nations are exceedingly diverse and can only be resolved through WHEREAS:

closer bonds of international Christian understanding; and

As a free people, we have the extreme privilege of freedom of worship where all may pract the principles of Christian Fellowship and Philosophy, thereby gaining a proper perspects and peace of mind in these very difficult and troubled times; and WHEREAS:

We feel that it is of great importance that each of us encourage all Christians everywher WHEREAS: to do all that is in their power to help strengthen and preserve the Christian heritage of this great nation and to remember in prayer our brethren throughout the world; and

WHEREAS: We are keenly aware that there are those who would destroy these privileges;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 2 through February 9, 1983 to be

in Minnesota, and urge all Christians to give fitting recognition to the aforesaid principles.
