WHEREAS: The success of Scouting for Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts and Explorers depends on our community organizations; and

WHEREAS: There are 3,400 churches and synagogues, schools and parent-teacher associations, service and fraternal clubs, and other community organizations that have been chartered in our area by the Boy Scouts of America to use the Scouting program; and

WHEREAS: The volunteer leaders selected by these chartered organizations are performing an outstanding service for 81,479 boys and young men and women; and

WHEREAS: The Many Waters Area of the Boy Scouts of America and its corps of dedicated volunteer leaders are providing necessary support to the leaders in the 3,038 Cub Scout packs, Boy Scout troops, and Explorer posts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1983, to be
