WHEREAS: *The State of Minnesota is rich in natural resources and beauty; and*

WHEREAS: *I believe that every citizen should contribute to keeping his environment clean and healthful, should work together to preserve clean air, fresh water and the natural beauty of his surroundings; and*

WHEREAS: *Keep America Beautiful Week has organized millions of Americans for over a decade in a nationwide effort to improve the community environment by establishing recycling centers, restoring beachfronts, landscaping; and*

WHEREAS: *Keep America Beautiful, Inc., the national nonprofit public service organization responsible for involving individuals in community improvement, originated KAB Week to focus attention on the efforts of concerned Americans;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 17 through April 23, 1983, as
