WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes its nursing home residents and appreciates their generous contributions to our state; and


WHEREAS: We especially commend the many dedicated people who provide skilled and compassionate care for our elderly citizens 365 days a year;



NURSING HOME WEEK


in Minnesota.
