NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March 1983 as

in Minnesota, and call on each citizen to join the Minnesota Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers in this observance.

FURTHER, I urge each citizen to join and support the social work profession in its efforts to advance the quality of life in our communities.
