



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Council of the Knights of Columbus is conducting its Third Annual Tootsie Roll Drive; and

WHEREAS: With the State having adopted a policy of moving people out of the institutions and into group homes and regular households where they will attempt to live a more normal lifestyle, they will have a lot of special needs; and

WHEREAS: Our program will be able to aid those where the tax-supported programs fall short of many of their ultimate needs as they try in this change of lifestyle. Their stress will be increased at this time of relocation and we must be ready and be there to help; and

WHEREAS: The proceeds from this Tootsie Roll Drive are to be dispersed statewide and in accord with an approved list of recipients to help retarded citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 29, 30 and May 1, 1983, to be

TOOTSIE ROLL DAYS

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to support this program.
