The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at the Court House in the Village of Carlton Carlton County, Minnesota, on the 14th day of November A.D 1904, and convened as a canvassing Board to canvass the votes cast pursuant to Notice of Election called by said Board on the 8th day of November A. D. 1904, in the Village of Cloquet and certain adjacent territory, for the purpose of voting on the proposition of incorporating said territory into a City, to be known and have a corporate existence as the City of Cloquet.

That said Board carefully canvassed the votes cast at said election and found the result of said vote to be as follows:—

DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY ORGANIZED AND INCORPORATED AS THE
"CITY OF CLOQUET"

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of Section Fifteen, Township Forty-nine, Range Seventeen West, running thence East on the Section line to the Northeast corner of the Northeast quarter of Section Fourteen, thence South on the Section line to a point where the Section line between Sections Thirteen and Fourteen intersects the ~~main~~ North line of the St. Louis River; thence following following the North meander line of said River East and South to a point where the same intersects the quarter line between the Northwest and the Southwest quarter of Section Nineteen, Township Forty-nine, Range Sixteen, west thence west on the quarter Section line through Sections Twenty-three and Twenty-four to the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-two; thence North on the quarter Section line to the place of beginning; it being ~~the~~ intended to embrace by the above description all territory lying in Section Fourteen and the East half of Section Fifteen, Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-two and the North half of Section Twenty-three, the North half of Section Twenty-four and all that portion of Section Thirteen as lies South of the Northerly boundary line of the St. Louis River, being in Township Forty-nine in Range Seventeen west, and also all that part of the Northwest quarter of Section Nineteen, Forty-nine, Sixteen, as lies west of the Easterly boundary line of the St. Louis River; also all that portion of the Southwest quarter of Section Eighteen, Forty-nine, Sixteen, as lies west of the Eastern boundary line of the St. Louis River.

The population of the above described territory is about Five Thousand people and that said territory includes the duly organized and incorporated Village of Cloquet which said Village had a population of Three ~~thousand~~ Thousand Seventy-two people as shown by the last United States Census.

To Lewis Johnson, County Auditor in and for the County of Kandiyohi:

You are hereby notified that the electors of the Village of Spicer, which Village is partly situated in the Town of New Londen and Town of Green Lake of Kandiyohi County and State of Minnesota, at the annual election held in and for the said Village of Spicer on the 14th. day of March, A. D. 1905 voted upon the question of that the said Village of Spicer should become a separate election district, a separate assessment district and separated for all purposes from the said townships of New Londen and Green Lake in which said Village is situated and that the said electors did vote upon said question at the time and place hereinbefore stated, that the total number of votes cast upon said proposition was 51, of which 41 votes were cast in favor of said proposition and 10 votes were cast against said proposition, thus carrying same by a majority of 31 votes; and you are hereby requested to keep the records and tax lists separate and distinct from the aforesaid townships.


