

An Unsurveyed Island located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, Township 65 North, Range 3 East, 4th P.M., lying North 70° West 550 feet from the N.C. on S.W. corner of Lot 1 of said Section, containing approximately 2.20 acres.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Islands should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
