


Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Anoka-Hennepin School District No. 11 has been a leader in the Community Education movement since it was initiated in Minnesota at the 1969 conference on the Lighted School called by Governor Harold LeVander; and
- WHEREAS: The School Board has consistently supported the Community Education concept each year since the first legislation was passed in 1971; and


in Minnesota.
